The School Resource Office (SRO), has three main functions:

Safety

- The SRO works to ensure a safe learning environment for students, staff, and visitors.
- Duties also include investigating crimes within the school and making arrests when necessary.

Education

- The SRO teaches classes upon request on a variety of topics. Main topics include drugs, alcohol, search and seizure, and criminal laws.

Resource

- Lastly, the SRO is a law enforcement resource to the students, teachers, administration, parents, and the neighborhood surrounding the school. This individual can provide advice, help to resolve police related issues, and answer questions about police procedure.
